Storiel Activities Coordinator Commission



The Project

Gwynedd Council's Museums and Arts Service, which is responsible for Storiel, is keen to commission the Education Room Organising Co-ordinator for Storiel's Summer Activities.

Storiel is keen to be able to host drop-in activities for his families over the 2026 Summer holiday period. We are looking for an individual to outline different areas and give instructions to staff on how to set up the activities and think of history and art based activity ideas based on Storiel's collections. We aim to create an area where we can welcome families to do free activities throughout the Summer and can experience learning together and creating a craft.

This is a freelance appointment and the individual is expected to work closely with the Gwynedd Council team who run Storiel to draw up plans.

The main objectives of the project:

- Planning how we can best use the space for family drop in sessions
- Outline different areas e.g.
 - Craft making area (we have equipment)
 - Dress Up/Selfie Area
 - A 'soft play' area with the equipment we have
 - A play/build area with large blocks
 - Lego area
 - Discovery area
- Create a plan for staff to follow up to reinstall / tidy up
- Contribute towards the risk assessment for the activities
- Costing any additional equipment that needs to be purchased

The Coordinator

This is a freelance commission and it is essential that the Coordinator is:-

- Enthusiastic with knowledge and awareness of Gwynedd's arts and heritage culture.
- Experience of working with families / children of Nursery / Primary age
- Comfortable working closely with others and independently to help deliver this exciting project
- Organised and able to stick to a schedule

The ability to work from home or from an office on your own is essential and you have access to a computer and the internet.
